## Rock Maple Racing concludes season in Jackman

It was especially a good day for racers Eric Landry and John Scott, who saw success in their respective trail classes. The Trail racing class is designed for people new to the sport who want to try snowmobile racing.

For Landry of Nottingham, NH, it was a successful end to his first season of racing, calling the race at Long Pond Camps “the best of the season.”


“The course came together and my sled setup was finally perfected, just in time,” Landry said. After pressures from a close friend, Landry was introduced to RMR-XC and had his first race in Rangeley back in January. After the race, he never looked back. “I have been snowmobiling since I was about ten and this was my first year of racing...I should have been doing this at twenty.”

Landry admitted he was sad the season was over, after making the podium three out of the five races he participated in this season, including this past weekend’s race. As for the future, Landry is seeking to obtain a potential sponsorship and race in a full season with RMR-XC.

Scott of Littleton, MA raced for the first time in two years and claimed first place in the Trail 800 class. While Scott has been snowmobiling for quite some time, this was only his fourth race ever. “The day was a lot of fun,” Scott said. “The course was well-marked, not too bumpy or flat.”

Like Landry, Scott hopes to continue to race competitively in future races with RMR-XC.

“We’ve had such a great season with our past racers and being introduced to new ones,” Series President Tara Saxton said. “The weather was perfect in Jackman, a perfect way to close out the year. Given this was only our second season, we are incredibly grateful to our racers but also our sponsors and



their support in bringing the old RMR name back to cross country. We already can't wait to take our sleds back out with you in 2018!"
